Power to be

Power To Be Project - July 2017

Power To Be has acquired a 25 year lease of the former Prospect Lake Golf Course. HeroWork will help start the transformation of this 78-acre property into a world-class inclusive adventure-based hub. Once complete, Power To Be can provide even more inclusive adventures rooted in nature to people living with barriers. Inclusive adventure activities include: kayaking, canoeing, camping, surfing, hiking, fishing, and more.

The main focus of this Radical Renovation is to provide the infrastructure necessary for Power To Be to increase their programming and increase their offerings to the community. There are three main elements: campgrounds, waterfront, and naturalizing of the site.

The Campgrounds

The campgrounds will include 8 raised camping platforms with accessibility features, two accessible toilets, a post and beam gathering space, accessible paths and ramps, as well as a nature outpost structure.

The Waterfront

A dock will be installed at the site, and HeroWork's job is to ensure proper accessibility through pathways and ramps, as well as covered canoe, kayak and paddleboard storage, and fencing along the riparian zone.

Naturalizing the Site

HeroWork will start the process of bringing the site back to its natural state, which includes removing sand traps, tee boxes, fencing, and more. The goal here is to support the process of bringing the site back to its natural state, while adding site enhancements for recreational use.
